SAFIS is a coast-wide fisheries data collection system providing reporting applications for Atlantic coast harvesters, dealers, and anglers. The havester reporting application (SAFIS, eTrips) was the first application adapted to a moblie format.

The Favorites page lets you customize your own lists, so that you can quickly choose from the species, ports, and gears that you care about.

The Reports tab allows you to select, upload, and submit trip reports to fulfill your reporting requirements. You can also enter a Did Not Fish (DNF) report using this tab.

### 2. Setup and Start Your Trip to capture your trip details

When setting up a trip, you will enter your **Trip and First Effort details.** 

eTrips/M also offers the option to "auto-track" your trip, meaning the app will capture the date, start and end time, and catch location. Catch locations are kept on the device for historical use by the captain and are not sent as part of the trip report.

#### 3. Enter your Effort & Catch in real-time

You can record your effort and catch data without an internet connection! Enter a new effort each time you switch gears, change fishing areas, etc.

For each effort, you can record multiple catches. When recording a catch, you are able to provide the following:

- Species
- Quantity
- Measurement
- Disposition
- **Catch source**

## 4. Submit Your Trip Report & receive immediate confirmation

Once you click the "Submit Trip" button, the data will be entered into SAFIS. Only the information you submit as a trip report is transmitted to your reporting agency.

eTrips/M can transmit electronic trip reports to both state and federal fisheries management agencies.
