Committee members work together to develop strategies to collect and manage bycatch and protected species data, including at-sea and port discards and information on protected species interactions.

Current Committee Priorities

- Finalizing new methodologies for completing the bycatch prioritization matrix
- Testing the bycatch sampling program inventory application
- Explore potential for citizen science projects to fill bycatch data gaps

- Regular conference calls and as needed contact via email distributions
- Attendance at the biennial in-person meetings
- Active participation in all required activities
- Working with colleagues to complete the bycatch matrix

- Understanding of stock assessment and/or management needs
- Understanding of bycatch and discard issues
- Knowledge of fish biology and species interactions
- Knowledge of protected species
- Observer experience
- Knowledge of relevant fleet characteristics
